

New Business

Proposed that we use reserve funds to pay off the Trap House, total due \$43,198.00 Will be taken out of General Fund, saving us over \$1,000 a year in interest. Loan is at 4.5% interest. Approved by membership to pay off at 5/3rd Bank. Telephone notification system, a tool to notify members of up coming events and activities and work parties. Cost about \$1,000 per year for 500 numbers. Chris McGreevy volunteered to host the system, and help set up the numbers and Maintain. A lot of options are available in the system, with possible benefits. Approved by membership System will be tested and evaluated for one year. The Handicap Fishing Derby will be on May 14th, several projects need completed, a tree by the members lake needs to be removed, as well as several others. We will be trying to get the state to reimburse us 75% of our expenses to stock lakes for the event. Proposed that we spend up to \$750 max. 
