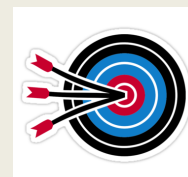

Congratulations!!!

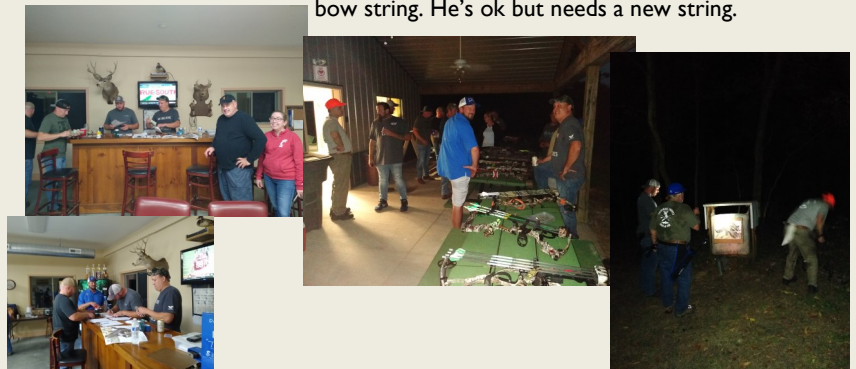
